
This document will detail the process of setting up a Single Sign On with Atriis using ADFS.

Follow the below instructions:

- 1. Client IT team Need to export Metadata from ADFS

- 2. Client IT Need to send over Metadata to Atriis
- 3. Client IT Import Atriis Metadata by using this link <a href="https://gtp-marketplace.com/identity/wsfed/metadata">https://gtp-marketplace.com/identity/wsfed/metadata</a>
- 4. Client IT Set WS-Federation Passive Endpoints as <a href="https://www.gtp-marketplace.com/identity/abcdef123456">https://www.gtp-marketplace.com/identity/abcdef123456</a>

abcdef123456: Atriis will provide the value to use. Example:



- 5. Client IT Make sure they are using SHA-256 as secure hash algorithm
- 6. Atriis IT Need to advise the "Secret" and "CompanyID" and send over to Client IT team
- 7. Client IT Add two custom rules
  - a. 1st rule
    - i. Rule Name: Secret

- i. Rule name: CompanyID
- ii. Rule content set as follows:

=> issue(Type= "https://www.atriis.com/companyid", Value = "123456");
